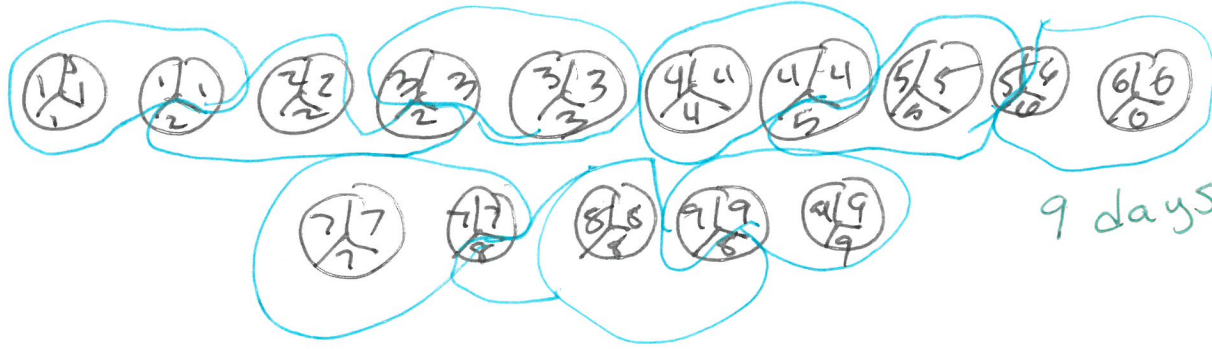
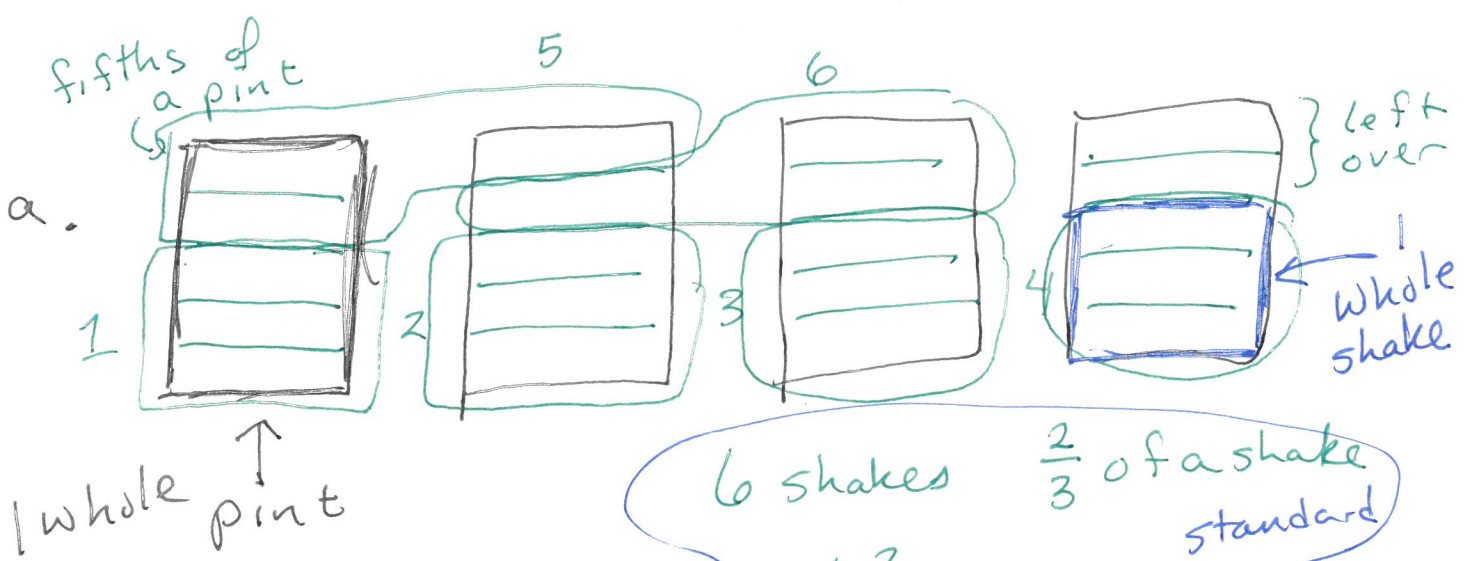

 $\leftarrow \text{parts in 1 whole shake}$

$\frac{2}{5} \leftarrow \# \text{ parts}$
 $\leftarrow \text{parts in 1 whole pint}$

6 shakes and $\frac{3}{5}$ of a pint of ice cream left over

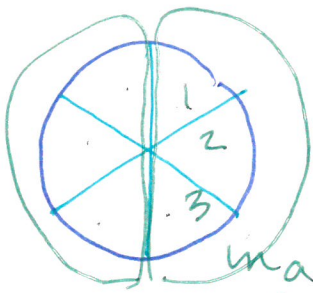
2b. $3\frac{1}{3}$ of a bowl

3 bowls and $\frac{1}{4}$ lb

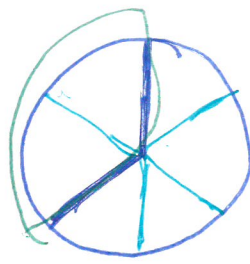
A batch of cookies needs $\frac{1}{2}$ c sugar
